### The money stuff!

### There are a few different options;

#### Sole trader - It's simpler to set up

- You are classed as self-employed for tax purposes
- You are personally responsible for your business's debts
- You have some accounting responsibilities

Partnership -A partnership is the simplest way for 2 or more people to run a business together.

- You are classed as self-employed for tax purposes
- You share responsibility for your business's debts
- You have accounting responsibilities







### The money stuff!

#### **Limited company**

- you are an employee of the limited company and are classed as employed for tax purposes
- its finances are separate from your personal finances
- there are more reporting and management responsibilities

#### Not for profit

• A not-for-profit organisation is a business that aims to do something other than to make profit for the owners, such as providing a public service or helping people. It needs to make enough money to cover its costs, but any surplus is reinvested into the business or used in other ways.

#### **Community Interest Company**

- a 'community interest statement', explaining what your business plans to do
- an 'asset lock'- a legal promise stating that the company's assets will only be used for its social objectives, and setting limits to the money it can pay to shareholders







# The money stuff!

#### What does all this mean?

#### **Tax & National Insurance**

You need to pay your tax and National Insurance - this is done through self assessment for a sole trader you can do it yourself or get an accountant

#### What about sick pay?

You need to set up your own insurance if you would like any form of sick pay - Summit financial services offer some insurance policies to cover loss of earnings - <a href="https://www.summit-fs.co.uk">https://www.summit-fs.co.uk</a>

#### What about Pension contributions?

Send your CV to potential employers; adapt it so the main focus is attractive to that particular employer


Ask about observation opportunities to get to know people
